10A.1&2. Private Sales of Public Lands

These Ordinances authorize the private sale of Public Lands in accordance with NJSA.

10B. Amend Ordinance 1577-04 as to Amend Sect 319-14

This Ordinance will create a No stopping or standing zone on the east side of Quail Hill Blvd.

10C. Amend Ord 1681-07 to Increase or Add Fees

This Ordinance, designated as 37-5 would increase or add fees.

11A. Authorize the State to Enforce Elevator Subcode

This Resolution authorizes the State to inspect the elevators in the Twp, as it will be more cost effective for only 50 elevators.

11B. Performance Guarantee Reduction/Redding Office Park III
