11A. Release Performance Guarantee upon posting Maint Guarantee/SMK

This Resolution authorizes the release upon posting the Main Guarantee in the amt of \$18,708.03, as the applicant has completed the requirements & was inspected by the Eng.

11B. Cancel Portion of 07 Drunk Driving Enforcement Grant

This Resolution cancels a portion of the grant, as it was based on monies received in 07 from prior yrs & \$11,889 was previously budgeted for under a different title & needs to be canceled.

11C. Apply for Grant Funding fr NJDEP/Tartaglio Park

This Resolution authorizes the Twp to apply for funding through the Green Acres Program in the amt of \$755,460.33 to fund the project at a cost of \$3,021,841.31.

11D. Apply for Grant Funding fr NJDEP/Veterans Memorial

This Resolution authorizes the Twp to apply for funding through the Green Acres Program in the amt of \$318,314.22 to fund the project at a cost of \$1,273,256.88.

11E. Refund Application Fee for Mun Towing License/AC Sports Inc
