11A. Financial Responsibility for Fire Hydrant

This Resolution authorizes financial responsibility for hydrant charges on Oakbourne Ave.

11B. Authorize Performance Guarantee Reduction for Redding

This Resolution authorizes Performance Guarantee reduction for Redding Commercial Group II, Redding Office Park II/Site in Galloway Township.

11C. Authorize acceptance of a Highway Safety Grant for aggressive driving

This Resolution authorizes acceptance of a Highway Safety Grant in the amount of \$6,000.00 to pay for Police Officers to work overtime to enforce laws effecting safety and welfare.

11D. Amend Adopted Budget (Chapter 159) for Aggressive Driver Grant

This resolution amends the 2008 Budget to accept the awarded 2008 Aggressive Driver Grant in the amount of \$6,000.00.

11E. Authorize Galloway Township to enter into an Interlocal Municipal Utilities Agreement w/EHC

This resolution authorizes the City of Egg Harbor to work in conjunction with Galloway Township in the collection of delinquent water bills.

11F. Authorize the refund of drainage contribution by Martin Building Co.

This resolution authorizes the refund of \$3,150.00 to Martin Building Company for the drainage contribution for 311 Xanthus and 311A Xanthus Avenue since it was determined that this fee was included in the construction of a subdivision in the area.

11G. Authorize the transfer of monies from Escrow Account to Sewer Operating Fund

An administrative fee balance of \$25.00 for a deferred driveway apron is in an escrow account and should be transferred to the sewer-operating fund.

11H. Authorize cancellation of outstanding checks issued by Galloway Township

This resolution cancels checks issued by the Township that are prior to May 31, 2007 listed on Exhibit A and never cashed.

11I & 11Q Renewing Alcoholic Beverage Licenses

These Resolutions authorize the renewal of Liquor Licenses.

11J Authorize Tax Sale Certificate

This resolution authorizes Joan Warren to purchase Block 1103, Lot 37, Brook Lane, a wetlands lot for \$700.00.

11K Removal of “school zone” speed limit

This resolution supports the removal of “school zone” speed limit and flashers along US Rt. 30 at the Assumption Regional Catholic School, which has moved.

11L Calling in of a performance bond letter of credit

This resolution authorizes the calling in of a performance bond letter of credit for the project known as Emerald meadows/Kensington Estates/Site.

11M Opposing Senate Bill S1608 and Assembly Bill A732

This resolution opposes S1608 and A732, which would enable a licensee to purchase already existing plenary retail distribution licenses.

11N Oppose Affordable Housing Bills A500 & S1783

This resolution opposes the Affordable Housing Bills A500 & S1783 as such will create property tax increases.

11O Interlocal service with ACUA

This resolution authorizes to enter into an interlocal services agreement with ACUA for the purchase of unscreened compost and wood chips.

11P. Approval to submit Grant Application

This resolution authorizes the approval to submit grant application for: Centers of Place Project, Widening of Chris Gaupp, Galloway Road Bikeway Project, and Reconstruction of Great Creek Road.
