



Radon is the second leading cause of Lung Cancer, after cigarette smoking. It is the leading cause of Lung Cancer among Non-Smokers.

Radon occurs naturally in the soil and can affect any home. Even if your neighbors have tested and did not have a Radon problem, your home may still have dangerous levels.

Fortunately Radon testing is easy and inexpensive. Test kits can be purchased at many local Hardware stores and Health Departments, or contact the Department of Environmental Protection at (800) 648 0394 or on the web at WWW.njradon.org for a list of contractors that provide testing services and kits.

Once identified, Radon problems can be fixed – For no more than the cost of a Typical Home Repair.
