**Galloway Township Offers Solution to Yard Waste Buildup**

GALLOWAY TOWNSHIP. Residents will get some relief this summer from the buildup of yard waste that has been stored on their properties or trucked at some cost to a regional landfill. The Department of Public Works will accept yard waste at the municipal complex site on Galloway Road beginning July 9.

Department Director Stephen Bonanni said residents can drop off branches and tree parts no larger than four inches around or eight feet long every Friday and Saturday in July beginning on the 9th. Hours will be from 8 in the morning to 2 p.m.

The township reserves the right to limit quantities and no commercial vehicles are permitted to dump the yard waste. Proof of residency will be required and only one load of branches will be permitted per resident per day. There is no charge for the drop off.

The township this year had to stop spring leaf collection and yard waste services due to budget cuts, said Director Bonanni. This limited program to help residents clear their lots of fallen branches does not include pick up services.

When the program ends July 31, it will be evaluated to determine whether it is economically feasible to offer the services again.
